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# Magazine table revamp



This upcycled project is great for making a bedside table – use up a collection of old magazines to achieve this unusual look. If you're anything like us, you'll have quite a lot of them at home...

## MATERIALS

- ☐ **24-30 magazines of the same size**
- ☐ **Top and bottom parts of an old table** (if you can't get hold of these, you can use two round cut pieces of MDF wood instead)
- ☐ **Extra-wide sellotape**
- ☐ **Wallpaper glue**
- ☐ **Strong bond PVA glue**

## EQUIPMENT

- ☐ **Scissors**

♥ **STEP ONE** Roll the magazine up, as tightly as possible. Fasten it with extra-wide sellotape.

♥ **STEP TWO** Repeat this process until you have around 24 to 30 rolled up magazines.

♥ **STEP THREE** Put these to one side. Use the sheets of another magazine to cover the two pieces of wood as you would with decoupage. Put aside to dry.

♥ **STEP FOUR** When it's completely dry, glue the bottom part with PVA glue and arrange the rolled magazines in a vertical position to form the base of your table.

♥ **STEP FIVE** Glue the top part of the table and place it on top of the vertical magazine base.

## TOP TIP

You can mix up your magazines for a varied look, but if you'd like to match your room scheme then you can always select similar colours.
