

## **TUTORIAL TUESDAY: WIRE NAPKIN HOLDERS**

Upcycle some wire, pipe and ribbon into these lovely napkin holders, perfect for Christmas!

Almie Louis is an enthusiastic crafter who currently lives in Stratford-Upon-Avon. Originally from South Africa, it's here that she published her first crafting book, from Drab to Fab, once her children were in school and she had more time to dedicate to her crafting.

Here's on such idea, from her book.

#### Wire Crochet Flowers

You'll need

Leftover plastic pipe (5cm wide)

Small amount of ribbon

Silver-plated wire, 0.8mm wide

4mm crochet hook

Scissors

Silver thread and needle

Fabric glue

Paintbrush

Mitre or handsaw

#### Simply make

Wind the wire around your finger to form a ring. Start to crochet,

Rnd 1: 1 ch, (1 dc in ring, 4 ch) five times, sl st in first dc to join.

Rnd 2: SI st in first 4 ch-sp, 1 ch, (1 dc, 1 htr, 2 ch, 1 htr, 1 dc) in each 4 ch-sp around, sI st in first dc to join.

### Fasten off.

Cut the pipe into 2cm wide rings. Cover the pipe rings with ribbon by coiling them around. Fasten with fabric glue.

Using the silver thread, sew the wire flower onto the covered pipe ring to form a decorated serviette ring.
