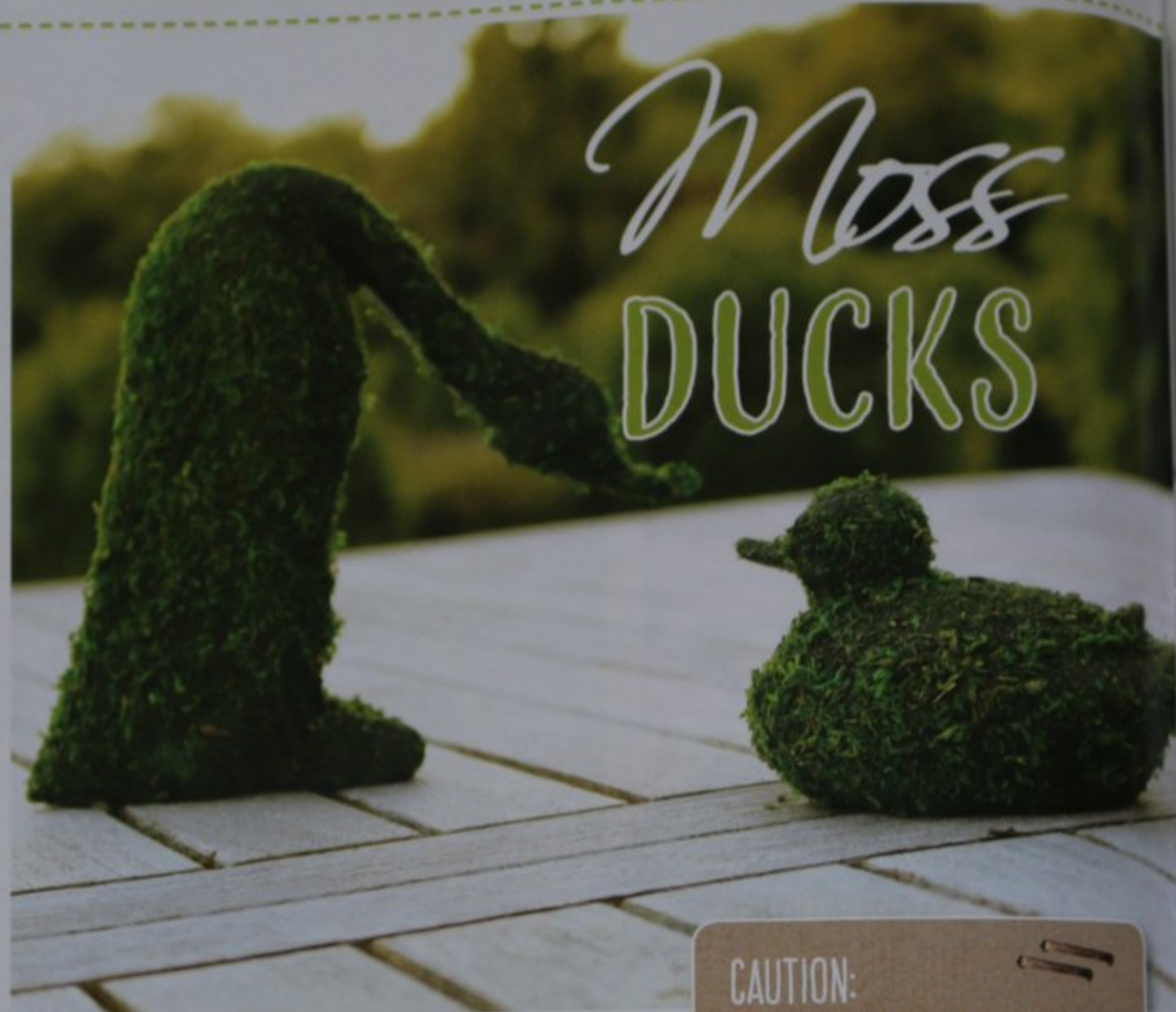


recycled items:

- Birds made from clay or porcelain
- Dry moss (pick it from the garden and leave to dry in a dark, dry place)

also needed:

- Green spray paint
- Spray adhesive
- Spray varnish
- Newspaper and old shoe box
- Protective gloves
- Spray mask
- Small teaspoon



CAUTION:
WHEN USING SPRAY PAINT, WEAR A MASK AND GLOVES AND WORK IN A WELL-VENTILATED AREA.

instructions:

- 1 Wash and dry the birds.
- 2 Place the birds on newspaper and spray them in quick, thin bursts. Wait for one layer to dry before spray painting the next one.
- 3 While waiting for the birds to dry, place the dry moss into a food processor to make a moss powder.
- 4 Place the birds in a small box and spray them with the adhesive. Use a teaspoon to dust the birds with the moss powder. Work very quickly before the adhesive dries. Repeat the process if there are any missed patches. Allow to dry.
- 5 When the birds are completely dry, spray them with the varnish and allow to dry again.
- 6 The birds are now ready for display! **CH**
